Through the November 5th Election, the residents of [Willow Creek Farms MUD](#) formalized a new first responder relationship with the City of Katy, and also approved the revenue mechanism to fund Fire Services through City of Katy (previously through Waller-Harris ESD 200 and others). This agreement builds on the existing relationship between the District and the City and deepens the ties between the communities.

The results of the multi-county election are:

- Prop A (authorization for Fire Service with City of KATY):
98.5% FOR; 1.5% AGAINST
- Prop B (authorization of Fire Tax to pay for fire service):
87.8% FOR; 12.2% AGAINST

With overwhelming community support, both propositions passed. Many residents can now expect to see adjustments to their ISO ratings, which are anticipated to reduce their homeowners insurance rates:

These cost saving agreements may help maintain and improve home values and will expedite overall Fire and EMS services for the District as the City of Katy has additionally committed to construct a dedicated EMS Station within close proximity to Willow Creek Farms MUD in the near future.
